January's financial report was distributed, reviewed and approved. The 2018 Budget will be distributed to the congregation on February 18.

**Outreach:** Still putting the committee together, working on our mission and vision statement.

**Personnel:** Evaluations completed, Crystal will assist Jennie with Pizza with the Pastor.

**Worship:** The Manning's will be out of town for several weeks; Travis and Barb will be ushers during that time. Randy Hall will be in the pulpit on Feb. 25, choir is working on Easter program (will include a trumpeter), Bill Whitney will be supply pastor on April 8.

#### TRANSITIONAL MINISTER'S REPORT:

Craguns are available May 5<sup>th</sup> which is also Spring Daze. The group, Eighth Day, are available on Sunday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:00. Session approved having the Craguns and Eighth Day perform. Plans are under way for confirmation class for 6 weeks, looking at Monday at 5:00 or Tuesday at 6:00. Met with Treasurer, Counters and Gladys Alexander to review process to acknowledge monetary gifts to FPC: Going forward the Counters will fill out cards with dollar amount and send to donor for tax purposes and Gladys will send letter of receipt to family. Planned and led Session Retreat, will lead Lenten Worship at Piedmont Crossing on March 7 at 11:30 am. Elected to serve as Vice Moderator of Executive Council for Salem Presbytery. Met with other ministers and the past Superintendent of Thomasville City Schools. Most recently have been in contact with the Assistant Superintendent regarding the donation of books for the children. We are moving forward with the book project, Pastor is helping to secure 23,000 books. All items donated for Houston Strong which were never picked up have been donated to Salvation Army.
